









Place the small ball and spring in ratchet head

Note

Use some grease to stick parts together

Mount the shaft in the ratchet anvil

Note:

Line up the gap in the shaft to the point of ratchet anvil Use some grease to stick parts together

Place the top chassis plate in to the FRP chassis and then the ratchet mechanism

Note:

Top plate is the one without threads

Mount the larger ball and spring in the FRP chassis

Note

Be cautious of the spring load!
Use some grease to stick parts together

Place the back chassis plate to the FRP chassis
Use the longer screws to mount the tool together
Use the shorter screw to fit the forward/reverse lever

Note:

Back plate is the one with threads Do not over torque
